



## Digital Collection of Stories

Take a moment to think about these questions. Write down the most important things which come to your mind. Use a cell phone to record a voice message. Pick one of the two tasks below and make a voice recording. Try to include your notes in it.

**// Task 1 a: Imagine that you are 20 years older and are telling a child who is as old as you are now of spring 2020. What would you say? Record the story as a voice message.**

**// or Task 1 b: Imagine you are telling someone about yourself during this time - as a fairy tale. Tell yourself like you are talking to someone else. Start your story with: "Once upon a time ...". Record the story as a voice message.**

The second task also demands a cell phone , an attentive eye and a bit of your imagination!

**// Task 2 video: Now it's about your perspective of the places and things around you! How can you show your perspective to other people with a video?**

**Find a place or object near you. How can you create a typical OR changed perspective of the object or place through a short clip?**
